

Palm Beach International Boat Show 2022: Functional layout on 145-foot II' Barbetta includes a glass elevator

The 145-foot Il' Barbetta, one of Benetti's "Vision 145" series of full displacement yachts, features a well-appointed functional layout designed by Stefano Righini, with the interior decor by Bannenberg & Rowell.

"Il' Barbetta has been maintained in flawless condition and just completed a major multimillion-dollar refit including new exterior paint, teak decks, mechanical systems, and much, much more. She is turnkey in all respects," said John Cohen, director of sales and charter at Merle Wood & Associates.

Unusual for its class, it is fitted with a central three-person glass elevator. Its bright airy main salon features a pleasing neutral color palette that sets off rich honey-toned wood finishes.

The yacht offers many outdoor areas set up for entertaining. The aft deck is comfortably furnished for alfresco dining, and inviting hours of laid-back leisure time, highlights on the sundeck include a Jacuzzi, lounge area, and wet bar.

Il' Barbetta accommodates up to 12 guests in a five-stateroom layout: the forward-facing master stateroom, which offers a 270-degree view and opens to a private deck on the bow; two VIP cabins with queen beds; and two twin cabins, each with Pullman berths. All ensuite bathrooms are finished in marble. There are also quarters for nine crewmembers.

The yacht also has a fully equipped gym, an assortment of water toys, and a beach club.

With a fiberglass composite hull and teak decks, Il' Barbetta has a beam of 29 feet, a draft of 9 feet, and it measures in at 456 gross tons. Twin Caterpillar 1,250-horsepower engines give the yacht a cruising speed of 12 knots and a maximum speed of 15 knots. The yacht is priced at \$14.5 million.
